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Application for Defense of Dissertation

You must submit this application *not less than 30 days* before you and your advisor wish to schedule your oral defense. The dissertation must be essentially finished before this application may be submitted (a few minor changes may be made, such as footnotes or grammatical or style problems, but no new substantive changes are allowed after submission of this application). You and your advisor are responsible for determining the appropriate date for your defense and completing this application together.

The Graduate Legal Studies (GLS) Office will handle all coordination, scheduling, and advertising of the date and room for your defense. Please do not attempt to contact your advisor or other defense committee members if the date or place needs to be changed. All changes should be made through the GLS Office. In addition to this form, you will need to submit the following materials:

- an electronic copy of your dissertation, including bibliography
- an electronic summary of your dissertation (no more than two paragraphs)
- an electronic biography (no more than one paragraph)

All electronic materials should be sent to Ms. Lara Gose (lgradadm@indiana.edu). Please note that if any of your committee members request a paper copy (instead of an electronic copy) of your dissertation to review, you will also be required to submit these copies to the Graduate Legal Studies office. The defense application will not be considered complete without all of these items.

You should consult with your dissertation director to determine how to manage your presentation. You may send Ms. Gose an electronic copy of materials you wish to use as handouts to supplement your presentation the day before your defense is scheduled to have copies made. The Graduate Legal Studies office also provides light refreshments for you, your committee, and any others in attendance at your defense. Most defenses take place in the Faculty Conference Room (Law 335), and you should expect to have access to the room 30 minutes prior to the start of the defense.
