according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for fractional Section fifteen, in Township thirty-eight north, of Range four West, in the District of Indiana, containing one hundred and twenty-seven acres, and fifty-five hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plot of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said William Niggins Taylor,

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said William Niggins Taylor,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said William Niggins Taylor, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
