Policy for taking courses outside the Law School:

- 1) The requested outside course must be deemed by the Law School to have significant intellectual challenge for a law student (i.e., most often a graduate course).
- 2) The course must be closely tied to the student's career goals or to his or her studies in the Law School.
- 3) The total number of non-law course credits must not exceed six (6) credit hours, including the potential credits of the course requested above.
- 4) There may be extra fees/tuition associated with adding a non-law class. See Catherine Matthews or Paul Leopold for more information.
- 5) Only IU Bloomington courses will be approved.
- 6) The course must not duplicate a course offered by the Law School or a course previously taken by the student.
- 7) Credit will be given for the hours earned and a grade of 'Pass' will be recorded upon receipt of evidence of satisfactory completion ("C" or higher) of the course.
- 8) Students are responsible for registering (or withdrawing) themselves for the non-law class. This may involve obtaining instructor and/or departmental authorization for the course.
